WMFC and Partners Serve a Community in Need

Over the past four years, in response to community need, West Midland

Family Center (WMFC) has ramped up its food distribution program. Several factors have fueled the on-going need, including: local flooding in 2020, the persistent pandemic with its after effects and the fact that families in our vicinity live in a food desert. The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) generally defines a food desert as "an area lacking access to affordable fruits, vegetables, whole grains, low-fat milk, and other foods that make up the full range of a healthful diet." A food desert can be in urban, or rural areas, where grocery stores can be many miles away, accessible only by car. If an individual lives in an area 10 miles from the nearest full-service grocery... that constitutes a food desert. The food desert category is an issue of a community's access to nutritious food, while **food insecurity** describes a household's precarious economic condition. The out-county region of **Midland County** falls under both categories.

Partnerships with Costco, Aldi, and Hidden Harvest have grown the WMFC food program. WMFC now receives enough surplus food to facilitate three food distributions weekly out of WMFC's large pavilion. In the past, although perfectly safe, food such as this would have been deemed un-usable tossed. and Now. this nutritious food is re-distributed to benefit the community. When this program began, surplus food items from

various suppliers were distributed in a free-formanner on pallets all near the WMFC north entrance. Patrons would grab and go, hopefully, taking only what they needed and would use. It didn't take long to outgrow this system. The amount of food and the number of 'customers' made this arrangement unsustainable. Concern for equity of allocation, prompted a move first to staff-monitored one pavilion, then to the large pavilion supervised by 5 -10 volunteers and staff members who

Jeremy Wilkins, Beloved Community Servant

WMFC and the world lost a special friend recently. Jeremy Wilkins, a much beloved member of the community passed away from COVID-19 on December 17, 2021. He was part of a large family growing up in Midland and he leaves behind a large family now in Arizona. Jeremy was a 23-year veteran of various law enforcement agencies and most recently served as an officer in the Chandler **Police** Department. Arizona Hundreds of fellow officers attended his funeral and formed an impressive motorcade as a sign of public respect.

"Jeremy graduated from *Bullock Creek High School*, and was a member of the inaugural *EAL/Dow College Opportunity Program Class of 1993*" said *Mike Ritt*, the program's first director, and current Secondary Science Teacher at *Mt. Pleasant Public Schools.*

"I first met Jeremy when he was in the 8th grade, his nickname "Hoss," and no one was questioned why," shared Ritt. "This gentle giant was loved by all. While you couldn't help but notice his size, his gentleness was even larger, and it showed in many ways. He and his brother Charlie (also a member of EAL/DOW COP Class of '93) were always the first to volunteer for community service projects. Service became a lifelong obsession for Jeremy," continued Ritt, "whether it was helping at WMFC, or in Louisiana in 2005 with search and rescue efforts after

Hurricane Katrina, or protecting a defenseless community as a member of the SWAT Team in Chandler, Arizona. I started as his mentor, but he became my lifelong friend."

Lastly, we'd like to thank **The Herbert H. and Grace A. Dow Foundation** for their matching gift programs that have allowed us to collect an additional \$750,000 on many of these same gifts. Indeed, this is only the latest in a long line of gifts that The Herbert H. and Grace A. Dow Foundation has granted WMFC over the years. Their first gift of

\$100,000 came in 1986 when Herbert Henry Dow II was President of the Foundation and WMFC was still housed in the renovated Greendale School #4, which was originally opened as a school during the oil boom in Midland County in 1931. The \$100,000 was to help establish an endowment fund. They followed that up with more endowment gifts, support for operations, building expansions, other capital projects and finally these matching challenge grant gifts. Indeed, over the last 37 years, The Herbert H. and Grace A. Dow Foundation has gifted a total of \$8,982,053 to WMFC, with all of that going to help make Midland County the best place to live, laugh, love, raise a family, and help our elders in a compassionate manner.

assure everyone benefits fairly. When food supplies run low before needs are satisfied. WMFC is for thankful the long-time partnership it has with the **Midland County Emergency Food Pantry** Network (EFPN). When such a situation arises for a patron with an extraordinary need, WMFC relies on the EFPN. WMFC makes a referral to EFPN, who screens and request. The need approves the is then met with food gleaned from the EFPN food pantry located at WMFC; working together in this way, needs are met and people have what they require.

As previously stated. the community WMFC serves is rural, and often struggles to secure nutritious foods for their families. conversations In recent with individual recipients, WMFC learned that the food program helps to significantly minimize a family's grocery bill.

Esther learned about the program from a friend at church. She often stops by WMFC and picks up food to supplement her cupboards. Esther stated that the program is *tremendous.* To make use of the items she receives. Esther has taken to canning tomatoes. spaghetti sauce, chicken soup and chili, peaches, pears and "you name it." She also dehydrates mushrooms and peppers. Esther's husband caught the preservation 'bug' and now makes jerky. Esther shared how helpful it is to receive grocery items that she would not typically buy for her family. In addition, the desserts and sweets are a nice treat which she freezes and parcels out over time.

Another patron shared that her mom is on a fixed income. She's thankful because, with food costs continuing to rise, having access to the WMFC food program has taken the **pr**essure off her mom's budget and puts healthy foods on her mom's table. Like most other customers, she was quick to give high praise and accolades to all involved in the food program including WMFC staff,
